Tertiary notes of tobacco and cedar mingle with a very intense spicy bouquet.

On the palate, the wine is vibrant on the attack with a beautiful liveliness thanks to notes of very fresh fruit. Its aromatic complexity rises as the tasting progresses with rising notes of menthol and eucalyptus offering an extremely refreshing finish.
